Make a Bosty Photo Collage Series

You will need: scissors, glue sticks, and photographs from home

In order to make your own photo collage series by using Megan Coyle's Bosty character, you will do the following:

1. Select the photographs you'd like to use for your Bosty series. Remember that your photographs should be images of specific places and settings – they can include buildings, parks, restaurants, and rooms in your house.
2. Follow the dotted line when cutting out the different sized Bosty images from this worksheet. Keep in mind that the larger Bosty's face is, the closer he will seem to us in your photograph. The smaller Bosty's face is, the further away he will seem.
3. Place a Bosty cut-out on top of each photograph. Move the cut-out around until you find a good spot for Bosty.
4. Glue the Bosty cut-outs onto the photographs. If his face is hanging over the edge of a photograph, you can cut it slightly so it lines up with the photo.



5. Share your Bosty collages with the class. Can they guess where he is? Can you tell them what he's doing? Imagine you've gone on a trip with Bosty, and these photographs are images from your trip. What did you and Bosty do? What did you see? Are there details in each photograph that help your classmates guess where Bosty is?
